### Europe – Sutton Hoo

As part of our history topic on Anglo Saxons, Europe will be visiting Sutton Hoo national park in Woodbridge Suffolk on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025. During the visit we will be:

- Taking a guided tour around an Anglo-Saxon burial ground;
- Discovering real artefacts found at Sutton Hoo;
- Exploring Anglo Saxon Runes.


To make the most of our day we will be leaving at 8:45am and therefore ask all children to be dropped off at school by **8:30am** to ensure a prompt departure. We will also be returning to school slightly later than the normal school day at approx. **3:30pm** (traffic permitting).

The children will need to be in their school uniform and must bring a packed lunch, drink, appropriate outerwear and a suitable rucksack/bag to carry them in. Some of the exhibitions are outside and children will need to keep belongings with them all day.
